President's Report

- 2023-24 budgets were received and approved. 2024-25 school year budgets are due to the FBPA board by June 30, 2024.
- The Band Tower is completed. It will be painted when the weather permits.
- Board positions needed for the 2024-25 school year: Concessions Lead and Treasurer. It was discussed to possibly divide the concessions position.
- A new vendor was used for the Disney shirts , Elk Promotions. Positive feedback was received by those who ordered the merchandise.
- The scholarship is currently with the attorney and an additional meeting will need to take place with the directors to ensure all needs are included.
- There will be no meeting in December. The next meeting will be January 17, 2024.

Treasurer Report

- Under the Lights brought in \$12,523. These funds, along with the 5th Quarter, are used to purchase new instruments and uniforms for the band.
- Berlin Middle School fundraiser brought in over \$8,800. The Berlin MS Choir will be selling poinsettias for the holidays.
